RENTAL RATES & INFORMATION

Daily Rental Fee for Self-Catered Groups

- For parties of 12 people or less: **\$350/day** (NB: special rates apply to Youth Programs)
- Each additional person **\$22/day**

(50% Daily Rental Fee applies to days on which parties arrive after 5 pm or on which they depart prior to 11 am.)

The Daily Rental Fee includes any use your party may make of the commercial kitchen. Your party is responsible for leaving the kitchen, cooler, stoves, etc. in the same condition as they were found. If any additional clean-up of the site is required, \$100 will be withheld from your security deposit.

Due to the difficulty of removing garbage and recycling there is a \$50 fee unless the group prefers to do it themselves.

- Cleaning after overnight rentals **\$100**
These chores include emptying the garbage, removal of bedding, sweeping, and mopping. A list is supplied. There is no charge if your party does these chores.
- Additional Boat Trips **\$40/trip**
*The Daily Rental Fee includes all boat trips which your party may require **within 1 hour** of the scheduled arrival and departure time. Any boat trip outside that period entails the specified fee.*

Additional Facility/Equipment Rental

- Canoes/kayaks **\$20/day each**

Discounts

- Non-profit organizations and United Church groups: 10% discount

RESERVATION PROCEDURE

1. Your reservation of MacKenzie Camp is not confirmed until the **\$250 (non-refundable) security deposit** is received along with the signed rental agreement.
2. If the number in your party is less than the figure stipulated in the rental contract, you may request a reduction in the Daily Rental Fee. **However**, a) you must alert MacKenzie Camp to the smaller number no less than 10 days prior to the rental period for catered rentals and 7 days prior for self-catered rentals and b) for catered rentals the Daily Rental Fee stipulated in the contract may be reduced by no more than 25% as a consequence of your change of plans.



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3. Should you choose to use the climbing wall, prior documentation will be required that a member of your party has the appropriate certification. The costs of hiring certified personnel are borne by the rental party.

INSURANCE

Renters must provide their own liability insurance coverage, and agree to indemnify MacKenzie Camp and the United Church of Canada against damages, costs and expenses due to accidents involving any member of their party while renting MacKenzie Camp. \$2,000,000 liability coverage is recommended. Proof of insurance is required.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Swimming and all other activities are at your own risk.
2. No illegal drugs or firearms are allowed on site.
3. Do not cut down any trees, bushes or shrubs.
4. No pets allowed.
5. Long distance phone calls may be made on our phones, but must be logged. (Note: there is hi-speed internet at the camp, but no cellphone reception.)
6. No loud music, partying or fireworks.
7. Additional policies are outlined in the appropriate rental agreement

Please keep in mind that we are a church camp with neighbours close by.

Alice Large Dining Hall & Dormitory

- Dining hall seating for 99 and a small sitting area
- 8 dorm rooms: 7 with 6 beds (3 bunks) and 1 with 4 beds (2 bunks) and 1 queen-size bed

Henry Peters Cabin

- Sleeps 11 (5 bunks+)

Craft Hall

- Fireplace heating; meeting area for 50
